



Shakespeare in Detroit is looking for an energized, dependable and experienced part-time Teaching Artist to begin in January 2025 to support the organization's STEAM program.

Shakespeare in Detroit's STEAM program teaches the **Science** of lighting, the **Technology** of sound design, the **Engineering** of a form or costume, the **Art** of classical performance and the **Mathematics** of set building.

This is a great opportunity for a theater artist to make supplemental income while pouring into the city's future generations working with, primarily, middle and high school students (with some exceptions as we may work with elementary school level youth at times).

Teaching Artists not only teach the STEAM curriculum, they are also arts educators, cultural bearers and community artists who help nurture the whole child from reading and writing to self-confidence to collaboration and leadership skills in addition to transferable vocational tools.

The opportunity takes place mostly in Detroit schools with some workshops taught across Metro Detroit.

Must pass a background check.

Required skills:

- Must have at least 2-to-5 years of teaching experience.
- Must have at least 5 years of experience working in theater: costume designers, actors, set designers, lighting designers and sound designers are encouraged to apply.
- Must feel comfortable speaking publicly and engaging with youth, educators, principals, parents and other community members.
- Must be self-driven i.e. prep for classes independently, apply the principles of the STEAM program, show up on time for classes, meetings and other required events along with reporting hours within a timely manner.
- Must have reliable transportation.
- Must be able to lead groups of young people in improvisation games, vocal exercises, movement, text and other theater related activities in a creative and fun way.
- Must be able to coordinate classroom lessons with Lead Teaching Artists, Designers, etc.
- Must be proficient with Microsoft Office and Google Docs.
- Must be able to teach basic theater history.
- Must complete orientation with Lead Teaching Artist(s) and/or SiD Leadership
- Must have strong leadership skills

- Must have a passion for arts education
- Must be available during school hours
- Bilingual teaching artists encouraged to apply (Spanish/English)
